32nd GSP NATIONAL ENCAMPMENT

1. The Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) will hold the 32nd National Encampment City with the theme "Our Rights and Responsibilities" on October 18-26, 2003 at the Alano Regional Program and Training Center, Toril, Davao.
