4<sup>TH</sup> NATIONAL CONGRESS ON MENTAL RETARDATION AND AWARDING OF THE MOST EFFECTIVE SPED CENTERS

Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. In line with the Presidential Proclamation No. 240, Declaring the Period for 2003 to 2012 as the Philippine Decade of Persons with Disabilities and in preparation for the International Day of Disabled Persons, the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education (SPED-BEE), Department of Education, in coordination with the Philippine Association for the Retarded (PAR) will hold the 4<sup>th</sup> National Congress on Mental Retardation and awarding of the Most Effective SPED Centers at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on October 27-29, 2003.
- 2. The theme of the year's congress is "Empowerment and Full Participation". The congress aims to:
  - a. share the thoughts and feelings of children and youth with mental retardation concerning their empowerment and full participation;
  - b. share best practices on the inclusion of children and youth with mental retardation in regular schools:
  - c. provide strategies that promote productive life among these children and youth; and
  - d. award the most effective SPED Centers.
- 3. Local specialists on the education and rehabilitation of persons with mental retardation will be invited as presentors. They shall prepare papers based on their empirical researches/studies and experiences that focus on the theme.
- 4. Special education and regular teachers, school administrators from public and private schools, Education Supervisors in SPED at the division and regional offices, Chiefs/Assistant Chiefs of the Elementary and Secondary Education Divisions, Schools Superintendents, Assistant Schools Superintendents and representatives from the Parents Organizations of Children with Special Needs, National Council for the Welfare of Disabled Persons, other Government Offices (GOs) and Non-Government Offices (NGOs) working for children with special needs are expected to attend on official business. School administrators should make arrangements for classes left by teachers who would participate in the conference.
- 5. A registration fee of Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00) shall be charged to live-in participants which shall include board and lodging for three (3) days, conference kits, handouts and certificates. The first one hundred (100) to register on or before September 30, 2003 shall be given ten percent (10%) discount of the registration fee.

- 6. Participation of learners with mental retardation, 15 years and above is encouraged. At least two (2) of these learners accompanied by a SPED teacher will represent each division. Each will be charged only Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00) board and lodging for three (3) days. Expenses for the participants from the 22 TEEP provinces shall be charged against the TEEP project fund, while others could be sourced out from local funds as provided for in Presidential Proclamation No. 240 (copy enclosed) subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Expenses incident to the participation of the DepED teachers, administrators and other officials shall be charged to local funds. Participants from private institutions and other agencies shall make their own financial arrangements with their respective offices.
- 7. The program of activities is found in Enclosure No. 1 while the pre-registration form is in Enclosure No. 2. Pre-registration is encouraged to facilitate the preparation of materials. The form should be sent to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City.
- 8. Educators working for children with mental retardation are invited to present papers. The presentor's information form is found in Enclosure No. 3
