10th DepEd-RCBC SHORT STORYWRITING CONTEST ON ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND CONSERVATION

A. TECHNICAL RULES

- 1. The contest is open to all students of **public and private** elementary schools nationwide. Students enrolled in a home study program of the Department of Education (DepEd) are also qualified to join.
- 2. Contestants should accomplish the official entry form which can be obtained from all RCBC Business Centers nationwide. DepEd offices and selected schools. The official entry form may be photocopied.
- 3. The official entry form should be signed by the English/Filipino teacher and the school principal to certify that the contestant is a bona fide student of the school he/she represents and to validate that the entry is a true work of the child. For students enrolled in home study program, the entry form should be signed and certified by DepEd.
- 4. The contestants should submit a short story about caring for the environment.
- 5. The contest has two categories. English and Filipino, with two segments: Segment A for Grades I to IV and Segment B for Grades V to VII.
- 6. The contestants should submit only one entry, either in English or in Filipino.
- 7. Entries for Segment A should have at least 80 but not more than 200 words. Entries for Segment B should have at least 200 but not more than 800 words.
- 8. The pages of the story should not bear the contestant's name, nor identify the student's school or level.
- 9. Contestants must submit five (5) copies of the story with attached official entry form
- 10. Entries should be typewritten double-spaced. Handwritten entries are also accepted as long as they are printed and double-spaced.
- 11. Submit entries to the nearest RCBC Business Center on or before November 28, 2003.

B. JUDGING OF ENTRIES

- 1. The short story must reflect a child's point of view and be characterized by originality, freshness and creativity in choice and treatment of topic. It must charm both the child and adult readers.
- 2. Judges are independent bodies not connected to RCBC.
- 3. Judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
- 4. A total of four (4) grand prize winners will be selected. One winner will be declared for each segment and category.

C. WINNERS AND PRIZES

1. Prizes will be as follows:

► P3,000.00 as token prize plus Certificate of Recognition

Grand Prize Winners

- Student P30,000.00 cash and trophy; winning entry will be printed in the next RCBC "Nature Studies" book plus a scholarship package worth P25,000 from Grepalife and Pacific Plans. Inc.
 - ➤ School P20.000.00 and a trophy
 - ► English/Filipino teacher P5.000.00
- 2. Winners and their respective schools will be notified through formal letters addressed to them and their respective principals. Their names will be announced through print advertisements.
- 3. All winning entries will become property of RCBC. All non-winning entries will not be returned.
- 4. Previous grand prize winners are no longer qualified to join the contest.
- 5. Employees and relatives up to the 2nd degree of consanguinity and affinity of Rizal Commercial Banking Corporation, its PR and advertising agencies are disqualified to join the contest.
