2003 MID-YEAR NATIONAL VALUES EDUCATION CONGRESS

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The *Pambansang Samahan para sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga* (PSEP), Inc. will hold its 2003 Mid-Year National Values Education Congress on November 27-28, 2003 at the Crown Peak Hotel, Subic, Olongapo City.
2. This Congress theme is focused on "*Paghubog sa Pagkatao: Bigkis ng Lipunang Matatag at may Dignidad*". It aims to: (a) discuss issues and concerns on holistic values development; (b) raise awareness on the roles of the family, school, church and community in shaping the personhood of an individual as bases for the promotion of a just and humane society; and (c) encourage active participation among Kabataang-PSEP (KPSEP) members by showcasing their talents via the 1st *Tagis Talino* and *Sayawit sa Edukasyon sa Pagpapahalaga* competitions.
3. The highlight of the Congress will be the 1st *Tagis Talino* and *Sayawit sa EP* competitions. Please see enclosure for the contest rules and regulations.
4. Participants to the Congress are PSEP officers and members, KPSEP members, Values Education supervisors, department heads, coordinators, teachers in public and private elementary and secondary schools, students and parents.
5. A registration fee of Two Thousand Pesos (PhP2,000.00) for professionals and One Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (PhP1,800.00) for the students will be charged to each participant for board and lodging, Congress materials, and food for two days. KPSEP members and student participants may charge their registration fee to the school funds for student development, subject to the usual accounting and auditing regulations.
6. The first meal shall be the breakfast on November 27. In view of this, participants are encouraged to be at the Congress venue before 7:00 a.m. of this day.

1st PSEP Inc.'s TAGIS TALINO & SAYAWIT SA EDUKASYON SA PAGPAPAHALAGA

Contest Mechanics for Tagis Talino & Sayawit:

1. Contestants must be registered Kabalaang PSEP (KPSEP) members at the National Level.
2. Each division should send at least one to three (1-3) teams composing of 3 members each.
3. In case that there are more than three teams in a division, elimination should be done to meet mechanic #1. Participants coming from state universities and local colleges are considered national contestants and need not participate in the division elimination.
4. Each competing team should submit to the PSEP Inc. Secretariat a certification duly signed by the school principal/head bearing the names of the contestants and their alternates and the name of the trainers/coaches with their full mailing address and contact numbers ON OR BEFORE NOVEMBER 21.

Rules of the Contest – TAGIS TALINO

1. The teams will compete in the EASY (1 pt.), AVERAGE (3 pts.) and DIFFICULT (5 pts.) categories.
2. There will be 10 questions per category that relate to the contents of Values Education I - IV.
3. The competing teams are requested to prepare five questions each for easy, average, difficult categories to be submitted to the committee one hour before the final contest on November 27.
4. The quiz master will read the question and the team contestants will be given 15 seconds to write the answer on the flash card then waits for the quiz master's signal to raise their answer. The scorer will check the answers and tally the scores on the scoreboard until the quiz master finishes the question on the easy, average and difficult categories.
5. The three teams with the highest scores will be declared as winners (champion, 1st runner up, 2nd runner up).
6. In case of a tie, the quiz master will ask another three questions. The team with the highest score will automatically be declared as the winner.
7. Cash Prizes + Trophies await the winners.

Rules of the Contest – SAYAWIT

1. Sayawit presentation must be relevant to the congress theme.
2. Presentation time should not exceed 10 minutes.
3. Number of participants should be from 7 – 10.
4. Contestants may use props and other musical accompaniments.
5. Dubbing and lip-synching is strictly discouraged.
6. Cash Prizes + Trophies await the winners.

Criteria for Judging:

1. Relevance to the theme –	30%
2. Choreography and authenticity of movements –	30 %
3. Originality and Creativity –	20 %
4. Props, costumes, audio-visual effects –	20 %
