RULES AND CRITERIA

Outstanding Invention (Tuklas Award)
Outstanding Utility Model
Outstanding Industrial Design
Outstanding Creative Research (Likha Award)
Outstanding Student Creative Research (Sibol Award)

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 The contest is open to Filipino inventors, makers, designers and creative researchers residing in the Philippines.
- 1.2 Sibol Award is open to high school and college students. Entries have to be endorsed however, by their respective school heads.
- 1.3 Entries that have won 1st, 2^{nc} and 3rd prizes in previous national invention contests, except those under the Creative Research Category, are excluded from the contest.

2. CATEGORIES

- 2.1 **Invention** covered by invention patent still in force granted by the Intellectual Property Office (or BPTTT).
- 2.2 **Utility Model** covered by utility model patent/registration still in force granted by intellectual Property Office (or BPTTT).
- 2.3 Industrial Design covered by industrial design patent/registration still in force granted by Intellectual Property Office (or BPTTT).
- 2.4 Creative Research any patent pending or without patent applications inventions, utility models, industrial designs, devices, products, chemical/mechanical processes or researches with demonstrable qualities already commercialized or with potential for commercialization.

2.5 Sibol Award (Student Creative Research) – new and innovative projects/models developed by high school and college students. These projects/models should possess features and characteristics which may have significant contribution to the promotion of S&T innovations which are not contrary to public order, morals, public health and welfare.

3. AREA CLASSIFICATION (For categories 2.1, 2.2, 2.3 and 2.4 only)

- 3.1 Housing, Organizers and Construction
- 3.2 Food, Nutrition, Health and Education
- 3.3 Agriculture, Fisheries, Forestry and Natural Resources
- 3.4 Energy and Transportation
- 3.5 Communication, Entertainment and Information Technology
- 3.6 Environment and Sanitation

Contestants shall select only one (1) area they consider appropriate for their entry.

For Sibol Award, there will be no area classification but separate awards shall be given for high school and college levels.

4. CONTEST REQUIREMENTS AND MECHANICS

- 4.1 Contestants are required to submit the following to Technology Application and Promotion Institute, DOST Compound, Bicutan, Taguig, Metro Manila not later than 21 October 2003:
- Six (6) copies duly accomplished entry forms.
 - Form No. 01 for invention, utility model, industrial design and creative research categories
 - Form No. 02 for Sibol Award
- Two (2) copies of signed waivers
 - Form No. 03 for invention, utility model, industrial design and creative research categories
 - Form No. 04 for Sibol Award
- Six (6) copies of description/drawings, pictures

- Six (6) copies of the letters patent (if applicable) which includes specification, claims and drawings
- 4.2 Contestants may submit their applications through mail, fax, or e-mail to TAPI. However, original copies of the required documents must be received at TAPI on or before 21 October 2003 deadline.
- 4.3 Entries will be screened by a Panel of Judges prior to the contest proper.
 - 4.3.1 Finalists will receive written notification from TAPI. Only finalists will be allowed to exhibit his/her entry during the 2003 National Invention Contest to be held on 26-29 November 2003 in Metro Manila.
 - 4.3.2 Each finalist will be assigned a booth free of charge to display his/her official entry/ies. Each entry shall be identified by an official label provided by TAPI. Finalists will be notified later of their specific booth assignments/dimensions.
 - 4.3.3 Finalists should be available at the contest site to make a presentation to the Panel of Judges; schedule to be announced later.
 - 4.3.4 Finalists are required to install their working models/products/exhibit materials at the contest site in the afternoon of 25 November 2003. All exhibit materials should be moved out after the awarding/closing ceremonies on 29 November 2003.

5. JUDGING CRITERIA

5.1 Judging shall be based on the following:

- 5.2 Final judging will be held at the contest site. The Panel of Judges has the right to declare no winner if it deems that there is no deserving entry in the category. To be eligible for an award, the entry must garner an average rating of a t least 70%.
- 5.3 The decision of the Panel of Judges shall be final and unappealable. Contestants or their representative shall agree to the immunity of the member of the Panel of Judges, DOST, TAPI and their employees from any legal suit that may arise from or relative to the conduct, results, etc. of the contest by signing the corresponding waiver form. No entry shall be considered officially entered in the contest unless the contestant and his/her witnesses have signed the waiver and submitted the signed waiver to TAPI (please see related Item 4.1).
