15th YMCA NATIONAL ASSEMBLY OF HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AND 8th YMCA NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL CLUB ADVISERS SEMINAR

- 1. The YMCA of Manila in cooperation with the Department of Education will hold its 15th YMCA National Assembly of High School Students and 8th YMCA National High School Club Advisers Seminar at Junior Mess, Teachers Camp, Baguio City on November 20-23, 2003.
- 2. With the theme "Recognizing Diversity Towards Peace and Progress", the Assembly specifically aims to:
 - a. broaden the participants' understanding of Christian leadership and encourage them to use this as basis for relevant and meaningful action;
 - b. empower the Filipino youth through their acceptance of civic responsibilities and the building of caring relationships; and
 - c. challenge them to promote initiatives as responses to the present issues and concerns affecting the country and their lives.
- 3. The participants in this Assembly are selected student-leaders and teacher-advisers from different public and private secondary schools.
- 4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Fifty Pesos (PhP3,050.00) shall be charged each participant to cover meals (starting dinner of November 20 to lunch of November 23, 2003), lodging, assembly materials, certificate of attendance and miscellaneous expenses. Deadline of registration will be on November 12 and 14 for provincial and Metro Manila delegates, respectively. Delegates are encouraged to come with clothing fit for Baguio climate, medicines for specific needs, camera and some souvenir items for exchange with other participants.
- 5. In as much as the YMCA National Assembly and Seminar are relevant co-curricular activities supported by the DepED-Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA), all regional directors and schools superintendents are requested to send their participants.
