- In response to the continuous request for orientation on guidelines for implementation of the 1. Basic Education Curriculum (BEC), the Department of Education (DepED), through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) in coordination with the National Association of Special Educators (NASE) will conduct an Orientation-Seminar for Private Schools on the Effective Implementation of Basic Education Curriculum on January 21-23, 2004 at the Manila Pavilion Hotel, Manila,
