NATIONAL CONGRESS ON REORIENTING INDUSTRIAL EDUCATION:
PERSPECTIVE FOR POLICY FORMULATION

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. The Technological University of the Philippines (TUP), College of Industrial Education, will hold a three-day live-in National Congress on Reorienting Education: Perspective for Policy Formulation on December 2-4, 2003 at the Capuchin Retreat Center, San Sebastian, Lipa City, Batangas with the theme "The Industrial Education Teacher in 2004 and Beyond".
- 2. The objectives of the Congress are to:
  - undertake a review of the policies and regulations issued by the Commission on Higher Education and the Department of Education including the national and international trends likely to influence industrial education;
  - examine the reform agenda in teacher education carried out by the CHED and the Teacher Education Council;
  - 3. review the 2002 BEC of the DepED and identify areas affecting the implementation of industrial education in the elementary and secondary levels of education;
  - 4. generate a general list of competencies of industrial education teachers in the current decade; and
  - formulate a position statement strengthening the implementation of industrial education in basic education.
- 3. Participants to this convention are Elementary/Secondary School Principals/Heads, Deans/Administrators and Faculty Members of SUCs with Industrial Education Program, Schools Superintendents or Regional Heads/Administrators of DepED and Curriculum Planners and other concerned professionals. Attendance to this convention shall be **on official time only**. Enclosed is the tentative program of activities.
- 4. A registration fee of Three Thousand Six Hundred Pesos (PhP3, 600.00) will be charged each participant to cover seminar kits, meals, lodging and certificate. Payments in check should be made payable to the Technological University of the Philippines (TUP).
