GENDER AND DEVELOPMENT (GAD) PROGRAMS

- In response to Republic Act No. 7192 entitled "Women in Development and Nation Building Act", An Act Promoting the Integration of Women as Full and Equal Partners of Men in Development and Nation Building and for Other Purposes, a substantial portion of government funds shall be set aside and utilized by the agencies concerned to support programs and activities for women. In view of this, the Staff Development Division-Human Resource Development Service (SDD-HRDS) will conduct the Gender and Development (GAD) Programs.
- 2. The objectives of the program are to:
 - a. eliminate gender stereotyping in textbooks and instructional materials;
 - b. raise gender awareness among the participants enabling them to be more committed and responsive to gender equality:
 - c. facilitate the concept of mainstreaming gender concerns in accordance with the provisions of RA 7192;
 - d. identify the different forms of violence against women and how to prevent them;
 - e. assess the status of the GAD programs in the region; and
 - f. develop a monitoring scheme in the different levels to sustain GAD advocacy efforts.
- 3. Refer to enclosure for the titles, schedules, venues, participants, facilitators and staff of the program.
- Travel expenses and per diem (before and after the training) of participants are chargeable against local funds, while board and lodging of participants and staff/facilitators and travel expenses, per diem (before and after the training), extra duty allowance of the project staff and facilitators and honorarium of external resource speakers and other incidental expenses of the training are chargeable against Special Program Funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
