2004 SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAM ON VISUAL IMPAIRMENT

To:

Bureau Directors Regional Directors

Schools Division/City Superintendents

Chairman, CHED

1. The Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) and the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE) in coordination with the Philippine Normal University (PNU), Cebu Normal University (CNU) and University of Southeastern Philippines (USP), Davao City, will conduct the Training Program for Teachers of the Visually Impaired. This is sponsored by the Resources for the Blind, Inc., Christoffel Blindenmission, Dark and Light Foundation and the Hildeshimer Foundation. The training venues and dates are as follows:

Luzon Area

Philippine Normal University (PNU)

Taft Avenue, Manila April 12 – May 7, 2004

Visayas Area

Cebu Normal University (CNU)

Cebu City

April 12 - May 7, 2004

Mindanao Area

University of Southeastern Philippines (USP)

Davao City

April 12 - May 7, 2004

- 2. The program aims to enhance competencies of teachers in providing educational services to visually impaired children in regular schools.
- 3. Priority participants/nominees in the three areas shall come from the identified regions/divisions/districts/schools where there is an urgent need for SPED teachers for the visually impaired (see Enclosure No. 1). The Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee (RISC) based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 2, shall screen the nominees. Deadline for the submission of nominees to the region is set on the first week of March 2004. The nominees are advised to make a collect call to Mr. Randy Weisser, Director, Resources for the Blind, Inc. at tel. no. 726-30-21 for the interview in March 2004. The Regional Office shall submit the final list of nominees and their required documents to the Special Education Division (SPED), Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) on or before March 31, 2004.

- 4. Selected teachers who are recipients of the DepED-RBI Summer Training Programs in summers 2002-2003 are listed in Enclosure No. 4. Only those teachers who are actually providing services to the visually impaired students will be given the opportunity to continue their training in Summer 2004.
- 5. All grantees shall be entitled to free tuition fees and a month's stipend. Grantees from Regions I, II, III, IV, VI and CAR under the training program by the PNU will receive a month's stipend of Two Thousand Four Hundred Pesos (PhP2,400.00) while those from NCR shall receive PhP1,400.00. All grantees are advised to travel by land or sea. Travel expenses shall be borne by the sponsoring agencies.
- 6. State colleges and universities as well as private institutions interested in offering undergraduate and graduate courses in special education or in providing services to children with special needs may send their nominees directly to the SPED, BEE, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City with the required documents. Travelling and training expenses shall be charged to their agency funds. The nominees who will be joining the training shall pay their tuition fees to the Resources for the Blind, Inc. c/o Mr. Randy Weisser.
- 7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

# CRITERIA FOR SELECTION OF NOMINEES FOR THE SUMMER TRAINING PROGRAMS IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

- 1. Is a Bachelor's degree holder for the elementary and secondary level.
- 2. Is actually teaching regular or SPED classes without training at the elementary or secondary level for at least three (3) years with Very Satisfactory performance.
- 3. Has a grade point average of 2.0/85% in the undergraduate/graduate/post graduate study.
- 4. Is not more than 45 years.
- 5. Is not pregnant or a nursing mother.
- 6. Has no administrative/criminal records.
- 7. Is physically fit, mentally healthy and register positive attitude and commitment toward work, peers and students.
- 8. Is willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses.
- 9. Has not availed of any scholarship program for the past three (3) years.
- 10. Can adequately communicate in both English and Filipino.

### PERTINENT PAPERS TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE REGIONAL INTEGRATED SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

- 1. Complete Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet)
- 2. Performance Appraisal Rating for the past three (3) rating periods
- 3. Certified true copy of Transcript of Records
- 4. Form 86 (Health Certificate)
- 5. Certification from Head Office (Principal/Superintendent/Chief of Elementary Education/Secondary Education Division) that the nominee is actually teaching and recommending him/her for scholarship duly endorsed by the Superintendent and Regional Director
- 6. Duly accomplished Scholarship Contract

- 7. Shall serve his/her school/agency for at least two (2) years after each summer training for a total of six (6) years.
- 8. Shall refund in full to his/her school/agency and to the Resources for the Blind, Inc. such sums of money as may have been defrayed by the Philippine government and/or sponsor if he/she fails to provide educational services to the visually impaired for two (2) years after each summer training; and
