- 3. Style of painting is free: crayons, colored pencils, water colors, etc.
- Paintings that have already been shown elsewhere or entered in other contests will not be accepted.
- Paintings that show a particular person, an organization or a brand name will not be accepted.
- Do not include any word in the paintings, because the sponsoring organizations will add adequate words to the paintings when they are made into posters, etc.

Number of winners may increase or decrease depending on the total number of entries.

Winning paintings will be exhibited in exhibitions, which are planned to be held throughout Japan as well as in the other countries, and they will be exhibited through the Internet as well. Selected paintings will also be printed into posters, post cards, calendars, or in a picture booklet or environmental magazines to be distributed worldwide.

After the competition, all entries will be collected in the National Museum of Ethnology in Osaka, Japan. In the future, the paintings could be accessed through the Internet.

Copyright of original paintings entered for the competition is to be assigned to the contest sponsor, Foundation for Global Peace and Environment. All paintings cannot be returned.

Winners' Selection:

Winners will be selected through a fair and impartial judgment process by the Judgment Committee under the chairmanship of Mr. Ryoichi Enomoto, artist.

Announcement:

Prize winners are to be announced in May, 2004. Only the winners will be notified by mail or through internet, and a prize certificate or a plaque with supplementary prizes will be delivered directly to the winner or his/her school or organization.
