

DepED MEMORANDUM No. 82, s. 2004

PROJECT MINDANAO UPGRADING OF SCIENCE TEACHERS (MUST)

To:

Bureau Directors Regional Directors Schools Division/City Superintendents Heads, Public Elementary Schools

- 1. The Department of Science and Technology (DOST), through the Science Education Institute (SEI) in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepED) through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), the Regional Science Testing Centers (RSTCs) and the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) through selected tertiary teacher training institutions in Mindanao announces the implementation of the teacher training under Project MUST in summer 2004.
- 2. The objective of the project is to improve/enhance the competencies/capabilities of elementary science and mathematics teachers of Muslim and other cultural groups in Mindanao.
- 3. The participants in the training are teachers of science and mathematics from schools where the majority of pupils are Muslims or are members of other ethnic groups. The training shall be held for two (2) weeks and shall be conducted in RSTCs and selected tertiary teacher training institutions.
- 4. The Regional Technical Committee (RTC) composed of the heads of the regional offices of DOST, DepED, CHED, RSTCs and of the identified teacher training institutions shall select the participants, supervise and monitor the conduct of the training.
- 5. The participants shall be exempted from paying the training fee. They will also be provided a stipend of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) for the duration of the training and book allowance and/or teaching materials of One Thousand Pesos (PhP1,000.00). Moreover, they will be given travel allowance including field trips and round trip fare.
- 6. The training shall be conducted in the following RSTCs and selected tertiary teacher training institutions:

 - Elementary Science Grades 5 & 6
 - Elementary Mathematics Grades 3 & 4
 - Elementary Mathematics Grades 5 & 6
 - Elementary Science and Mathematics Grade 3
- 8. Qualified and interested teachers of regions IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA and ARMM may apply at the respective teacher training institution/s. Details of the training may be obtained from the respective RSTC or teacher training institutions.
- 9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired and participation in the training program is a must.
