NATIONAL ENGLISH PROFICIENCY PROGRAM (NEPP) SCHOLARSHIPS FOR ENGLISH TRAINERS

TO

Bureau Directors Regional Directors

City/Schools Division Superintendents Heads and Principals of Secondary Schools

- 1. Department of Education, in partnership with the Southeast Asia Interdisciplinary Development Institute (SAIDI) is providing twenty (20) masteral scholarships for secondary teachers to further hone themselves as trainers in English with the use of technology. The Masters Degree in Instruction Development and Technology (MA ID. & T) will run for two summers and ten months starting May, 2004 and to end in May 2005.
- The scholarship program for sustainable technology integration (SUSTECH) seeks to address the need of teachers to use ICT through a research based immersion program, and fulfill the following objectives;
 - to provide an opportunity for professional development;
 - to acquire knowledge and skills at integrating various technologies in classroom teaching:
 - to create a community of practice in Instructional Development and Technology (ID & T) among new and young basic education teachers;
 - to earn a Master of Arts Degree in Instructional Development and **Technology**
 - to train mentors in school-based setting in support of the NEPP AND to serve as division/regional trainers.
- Each DepEd region is allotted one (1) scholar who shall meet the criteria for selection as specified in the DepED Inclosure. For further information please contact Ms. Perla Sunga Intia or Ms. Alice Panares in Telefax No. 638-86-38. Deadline of submission of applicants for scholarship is on March 30, 2004.

NATIONAL ENGLISH PROFICIENCY PROGRAM (NEPP) SCHOLARS FOR MA ID.& T. IN ENGLISH

A. STANDARDS AND REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The participant must have at least 3-5 years of teaching experience with DepED.
- 2. Must meet the standards of qualifications which are:
 - belonging to the upper 10% rater of the Self Assessment Test (SAT);
 - have taken the six-day Phase II-Mentor Training Program: Facilitating Mentor Learning:
 - must pass the Special Scholarship Examination conducted by NEAP-SDD:
 - * has no MA Degree or have no more than 20 graduate units;
 - execute a contract with the Department of Education:
 - must continue to teach the subject for 5 or more years after scholarship:
 - * in the event of pre-termination of contract for cause, the scholar shall pay the full amount granted to the Department of Education.
 - serve in the school- based training as division and regional trainer.

B. OBLIGATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION:

- 1. Pay SAIDI the school fees as counterpart to the scholarship;
- 2. Recruit, screen and qualify the candidates for the scholarship;
- 3. Orient the scholars on the expectations related to school-based mentoring;
- 4. Pay the scholars the amount of five thousand pesos (P5,000) as research allowance towards the end of the scholarship term.

The program is for two summers face to face in SAIDI office at Antipolo, Rizal, and ten (10) months conducting action- research in her/his own school.
