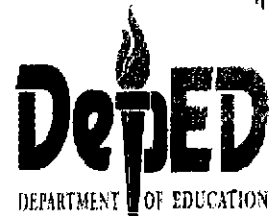

**2004 NATIONAL CONFERENCE FOR STUDENTS ON
LOVE AND CARE FOR MOTHER NATURE**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The OMEGA4SMB, an organization of student volunteers from various colleges and universities nationwide, in cooperation with the following Departments: Environment and Natural Resources (DENR); Agriculture (DA); Health (DOH); Interior and Local Government (DILG); Foreign Affairs (DFA); and Tourism (DOT); Office of the President on Special Concerns (OPS/SC); United Nations Information Center (UNIC); Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO); Linkages of the Philippine Normal University (L/PNU), Sun Cruises of the Magsaysay Maritime Group of Corporations (SC/MMGC); Youth for Sustainable Development Association (YSDA); and National Youth Commission (NYC) will conduct the *Kamp Kalikasan 2004* – a national conference of students who are members of nature clubs and campus media/publications at the Corregidor Island on April 21-23, 2004.

With the theme "*Uniting Nature Clubs and Campus Media to Love and Care for Mother Nature-Creating a Partnership for Productive, Peaceful and Healthy Communities*", the conference aims to raise the level of awareness and understanding among students on complex environmental and sustainable development issues and equipped them with practical know-how that can enhance their role as catalyst of sustainable development actions in their respective campuses and communities.

3. Members of campus-based nature clubs and publications in public and private secondary schools are encouraged to participate. A conference fee of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP2,500.00) shall be charged from each participant to cover cost of bay cruise, food, accommodation and conference kits.

4. All participants are enjoined at the Bay Cruise Terminal Pier located at the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP) Complex, Roxas Blvd., Manila starting at 7:00 am until 12:00 noon on April 21, 2004 for the sea travel from Manila to Corregidor Island.
