**THE 2004 INTEL® TEACH TO THE FUTURE ENHANCEMENT WORKSHOP  
FOR MASTER TRAINERS**

1. The Department of Education (DepED) through the Curriculum Development Division-Bureau of Secondary Education (CDD-BSE), in partnership with Intel® Technology Philippines, Inc. (ITPI), and in cooperation with UP NISMED, announces the holding of the 2004 Intel Teach to the Future Enhancement Workshop for Master Trainers between April 12 and 30, 2004.

2. The workshop aims to: (a) enhance the Intel Teach Master Trainers' knowledge, skills and confidence in using the inquiry approach, project-based learning and alternative assessment; and (b) orient them on the revised Intel Teach to the Future in-service curriculum in preparation for the conduct of the Intel Teach to the Future Cluster Training for the 1,100 recipient schools of PCPS Phase 2 in May 2004.

- c. Must be a Science, Mathematics or English teacher;
- d. Must be recommended by a Regional Trainer based on his/her performance and outputs during the Regional Intel Teach to the Future Training; and
- e. Must be competent and willing to conduct in May 2004 the Intel Teach to the Future Training for the recipient schools of PCs for Public Schools Phase 2.

6. The participants are required to bring with them their Unit Portfolios (Project Portfolios) which they developed as outputs from the Regional Training and supplemental materials in support of actual use of the Portfolios in the classroom.
