10TH INTERNATIONAL PORTAGE ASSOCIATION CONFERENCE

- 1. The Department of Education (DepED) through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) in coordination with the Portage Association of the Philippines, Inc. (PAPI) for Early Intervention will hold the 10th International Portage Association Conference on November 9-12, 2004 at the Manila Pavilion, United Nations Avenue, Manila. The theme of the conference is "Beyond Boundaries".
- 2. The Conference aims to provide opportunities for the participants to:
 - a. address programs and services to very young children;
 - b. share researches and studies;
 - c. advocate best practices on early intervention; and
 - d. connect with professionals, parents and other stakeholders around the world.
- 3. Regular and special education teachers, pre-elementary school teachers, school heads, supervisors, chiefs, assistant chiefs of elementary education divisions and other officials from the division, regional and bureau offices in both public and private institutions are invited to attend **on official business**.
- 4. A registration fee of Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP4,500.00) shall be charged each participant to this live-out Conference. This will cover lunch, morning and afternoon snacks for four (4) days, conference materials, honoraria for speakers and miscellaneous expenses. Early registrants (payment received on or before August 31, 2004) shall pay Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00). Expenses incident to the participation of DepED teachers, coordinators, administrators, supervisors, elementary education division chiefs and assistant chiefs and other officials shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing procedures. Participants from private institutions shall make their own financial arrangements with their respective offices.
