NATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM FOR SCHOOL PAPER ADVISERS

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

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- 1. Pursuant to the provisions of R.A. 7079, otherwise known as the Campus Journalism Act of 1991, mandating the Department of Education (DepED) to provide training program/seminar for teacher advisers, the National Training Program for School Paper Advisers shall be held at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on May 29 to June 1, 2004.
- 2. The theme of this year's training program is "Responsible Campus Journalism for a Strong Republic (Pampaaralang Pamamahayag Para sa Isang Matatag na Republika)" which was also the theme of the 2004 NSPC held at Sta. Cruz, Laguna.
- 3. The training program aims to:
 - a. underscore the relevance of campus journalism in the development of a strong republic;
 - b. promote journalism competencies through individual and team competition; and
 - c. hone the coaching/mentoring expertise of school paper advisers in radio broadcast.
- 4. The participants to this training program are:
 - a. 1 elementary and 1 secondary school paper adviser per division;
 - b. 9 officers of the Philippine Association of Elementary School Paper Advisers (PAESPA);
 - c. 9 officers of the National Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (NSSPAA);
 - d. 1 Regional Supervisor per region
 - e. 1 Regional Elementary School Paper Advisers (RESPA) President; and
 - f. 1 Regional Secondary School Paper Advisers (RSSPA) President
- 5. Participants shall be accommodated starting May 29. The first meal to be served will be dinner of May 29, while the last meal will be dinner on June 1.
- 6. Traveling expenses and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds/local school board funds subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

- 7. The traveling expenses of the members of the Working Committees, facilitators, speakers/resource persons to and from Baguio City, board and lodging of all participants, workshop materials and honoraria shall be charged against the Campus Journalism funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 8. The guidelines (Annex 1) in the selection of participants, the Working Committee (Annex 2) composed of the BEE, BSE and PAES/NSSPAA, the names (Annex 3) of the Philippine Association of Elementary School Paper Advisers (PAESPA) and the National Secondary School Paper Advisers Association (NSSPAA) are appended as indicated.
- 9. The Regional Directors through the Regional Supervisors, in coordination with the Presidents of the Regional Association of School Paper Advisers are advised to submit to BEE a definite schedule and venue of the training program in their respective regions. The information shall be appended to the DepED Memorandum announcing the schedule of Regional Training Programs for School Paper Advisers to be issued immediately after the National Training Program for School Paper Advisers.
- 10. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
