TRAINER'S TRAINING ON THE USE OF NSTIC BATCH B (PHYSICS MECHANICS)
SCIENCE EQUIPMENT (PHASE II) WITH REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE
AND TRAINING ON COMPUTER AIDED EXPERIMENTATION (CAE)
FOR SELECTED DIVISION SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents

- 1. The Department of Education-National Science Teaching Instrumentation Center (DepED-NSTIC) is currently undergoing the second phase of mass production and distribution of 515 of NSTIC Batch B (Physics Mechanics) Science Equipment to public high schools in the Philippines. Sixteen (16) of these schools are selected division science high schools which are the recipients of Computer Aided Experiment (CAE) accessories.
- 2. To ensure maximum use of NSTIC equipment in schools, DepED-NSTIC will conduct a four (4) day trainers' workshop on the use of the above mentioned equipment including on repair and maintenance at the DepED-ECOTECH Center, Cebu City on April 26-29, 2004.
- 3. Each region is allotted four (4) participants:
 - One (1) teacher from the selected CAE recipient division science high school who will be teaching mechanics in the next three years at least;
 - One (1) physics teacher from the new Batch B recipient schools who shall be nominated by the regional science supervisor;
 - c. One (1) general science teacher from the new Batch B recipient schools who shall be nominated by the regional science supervisor also. The physics and general science teachers may not necessarily come from the same school; and
 - d. The regional science supervisor is expected to join with his/her regional trainers.
- 4. Participants to the Computer Aided Experimentation (CAE) will come from selected division science high schools.
- 5. Teacher-participants shall bring with them at least one (1) reference book and one (1) defective science equipment preferably balances or microscopes.

- 6. Participants trained at NSTIC will become regional trainers and are expected to conduct echo training to recipient schools in their respective regions during the periods CY 2005-2006.
- 7. Participants' travel expenses to and from the venue shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Board and lodging, training materials shall be borne by NSTIC.
