22ND SAMAHANG PISIKA NG PILIPINAS (SPP) PHYSICS CONGRESS

To: **Bureau Directors** Regional Directors Schools Division/City Superintendents Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

- The Samahang Pisika ng Pilipinas (Physical Society of the Philipppines) will hold its 22nd Congress on October 25-27, 2004 at the Bohol Tropics Resort, Tagbilaran City, Bohol. The theme for this year's Congress is "Twenty-Five Years of Promoting Diversity in Physics".
- 2. The Congress will hold a forum for sharing the developments in Physics education and latest research in Physics, with additional sessions for industry-related developments. There will be three (3) days of plenary talks and refereed presentations. Participants will have the opportunity to attend high quality presentations and to meet and discuss with colleagues and co-teachers in Physics. There will also be workshops and refresher courses for Physics teachers and researchers alike. Participants are also invited to join the field trips organized by the SPP that are scheduled on the last day of the Congress.
