**NATIONAL CONSULTATIVE CONFERENCE-WORKSHOP ON THE REVIEW
AND REDESIGNING OF TECHNICAL-VOCATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM**

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Technical-Vocational High Schools

1. The Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), this Department, shall conduct a National Consultative Conference-Workshop on the Review and Redesigning of the Technical-Vocational High School Curriculum on May 20-21, 2004 at Kuhala Bay Resort and Convention Center, Cardona, Rizal.
2. The consultative conference-workshop aims to:
 - a. review the present curricular offerings of the technical-vocational high schools;
 - b. analyze the results of the survey questionnaire as input to the proposed curriculum design of technical-vocational high schools; and
 - c. recommend revisions in the curriculum of technical-vocational oriented high schools and its implementing guidelines.
3. The participants in the said activity are the heads of technical-vocational high schools identified in the enclosed list, selected Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE)/Technical-Vocational Regional/Division Supervisors and Heads of State Universities and Colleges (SUCs). The participants are requested to bring a copy of their present school curricular offerings and Learning Competencies in each year level to be used during the workshop. Participants are advised to assemble in front of the canteen, DepED Central Office, Pasig City on May 20, 2004 at 6:00 a.m. in preparation for the travel to the conference venue.
4. Board and lodging of participants and BSE staff shall be charged against BSE project funds while traveling expenses shall be charged against local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Names of heads of technical-vocational high schools participating in the workshop should be submitted to the Director, Bureau of Secondary Education, Attention: Mr. Alberto B. Dumo, at 3rd flr.
