Public and private school teachers and other members of the Board of Election Inspectors who are **registered in the cities or municipalities where they are stationed** may vote for candidates in the **local and national levels**.

On the other hand, public and private school teachers and other members of the BEI who are **registered in cities or municipalities other than their places of assignment** may vote for candidates for **national positions only**. In this case, they shall be considered as **local absentee voters** like members of the police and the military.




