**FIRST NATIONAL ORIENTATION WORKSHOP ON THE ALTERNATIVE LEARNING  
SYSTEM (ALS) FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT SUPERVISORS**

1. The Department of Education (DepED) through the Bureau of Nonformal Education (BNFE) will conduct the First National Orientation Workshop on the Alternative Learning System (ALS) for School District Supervisors at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on July 26-30, 2004.
2. The workshop aims to:
  - a. orient the District Supervisors on NFE programs and projects;
  - b. update them on the new trends, innovations and NFE practices;
  - c. discuss problems, issues and concerns that hamper the efficient and effective implementation of NFE programs and projects;
  - d. develop/enhance their skills in monitoring and evaluating the effective implementation of both the Basic Literacy Program and the Nonformal Education Accreditation and Equivalency (NFE A&E) System;
  - e. document experiences and best practices in the implementation of existing NFE programs and projects both nationally funded and locally initiated; and
  - f. raise the participants' level of commitment to ensure the sustainability of the NFE programs and projects.
3. A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos Only (Php4,000.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, handouts, kits and other workshop supplies and materials. Payment of registration fee may be in the form of cash or check payable to the Bureau of Nonformal Education (BNFE). Registration, transportation and other expenses incidental to their participation shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
4. Participants are requested to check-in at Teachers Camp in the afternoon of July 26, 2004 and check out after breakfast on July 30, 2004. ¶
