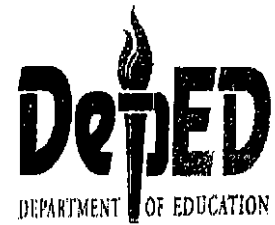

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ORIENTATION/TRAINING OF THE REGIONAL PILOT IMPLEMENTORS OF THE SPECIAL
PROGRAM IN JOURNALISM AT THE SECONDARY LEVEL

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. The Orientation/Training of the Regional Pilot Implementors of the Special Program in Journalism at the Secondary Level shall be held on June 1-5, 2004 at the Orchid Garden Suites, Manila.
2. The orientation/training is designed to prepare the Regional Pilot Implementors for their role in the program. Specifically, the orientation/training aims to:
 - a. introduce the Regional Pilot Implementors to the scope, nature, and mechanics of implementation of the Special Program in Journalism at the secondary level;
 - b. simulate with the teachers the use of the prototype lesson plans;
 - c. hone teachers' skills in desktop publishing; and
 - d. draw up plans for the implementation and monitoring and evaluation of the pilot program.
3. The participants to the orientation/training are the following:
 - a. 16 High School Principals of the Regional Pilot Schools;
 - b. 16 Regional Coordinators of the Special Program in Journalism at the Secondary Level;
 - c. 16 Journalism Teachers;
 - d. 4 Training Facilitators;
 - e. 2 Trainers on Desktop Publishing; and
 - f. 3 Bureau of Secondary Education Officials
4. The first meal of the participants shall be dinner on May 31, 2004, and the last meal shall be breakfast on June 6, 2004.
5. The transportation and other expenses of the regional participants shall be charged against local funds. The BSE participants shall charge their transportation expenses against BSE funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Board and lodging of all participants, honoraria of resource persons, supplies and materials, computer rentals, and other training expenses shall be borne by BSE.
