

2004 WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

General Information:

World Environment Day (WED) is commemorated each year on June 5. It is one of the principal vehicles through which the United Nations stimulates worldwide awareness of the environment and enhances political attention and action. Broadly, its agenda is to give a human face to environmental issues; empower people to become active agents of sustainable and equitable development; promote an understanding that communities are pivotal to changing attitudes towards environmental issues; and advocate partnerships that will ensure that all nations and peoples enjoy a safer and more prosperous future. WED is a people's event with colorful activities such as street railies, bicycle parades, green concerts, essay and poster competitions in schools, tree planting, as well as recycling and clean-up campaigns.

Contest Theme: The benefits of clean and renewable energy.

Contest Mechanics:

- 1. Participants are required to compose an essay on the theme: "The benefits of clean and renewable energy."
- 2. All essays must be written in the English language with an observed length of 1,000 to 1,500 words.
- 3. Essays must be typewritten or computer-typed on a short coupon bond (81/2" x 11"), using 12 pt. Times New Roman or Arial font. No names or identifying marks must be written on any of the essays for submission.
- 4. All essays must be accompanied with a fully accomplished entry form. Entry forms are available at all Aboitiz Express outlets nationwide and at our website, www.hedcor.com.
- 5. Enclose 5 copies of your essay, in a short brown envelope and submit it to any of the 339 Aboitiz Express outlets for free. On the envelope, write the following information:

- 6. All submitted entries would undergo screening and preliminary judging to determine the top 5 finalists. The finalists will be notified by phone and electronic mail on or before November 8, 2004.
- 7. The finals will be an on the spot essay-writing contest to be held at the Aboitiz Corporate Center, Makati, on December 3, 2004.
- 8. Deadline for submission of entries is on September 30, 2004.
- 9. Relatives within the first degree of affinity or consanguinity of employees of sponsoring institutions are disqualified to join the contest.

Criteria for judging:

Content: The weight of this is 35%. It covers the accuracy of data, relevance of message, and focus on the theme. Were the facts used generally accepted in the scientific community? Were the ideas discussed related to the theme? Was there adequate focus on the theme?

Organization: The weight of this is 35%. It covers the coherence of sentences and paragraphs, and unity of thought. Does the order and flow of discussion effectively communicate a message?

Style: The weight of this is 20%. It covers the originality and creativity of approach to theme. Is it unique approach to discussing the theme?

Mechanics: The weight of this is 10%. It covers the correctness of spelling, capitalization, punctuation marks, sentence construction, and use of English language. This also covers the strict compliance of the contest rules and requirements.
