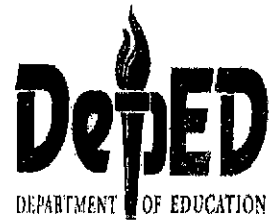

25TH ANNUAL NATIONAL GRADE SCHOOL CONVENTION OF CMLI

1. The Children's Museum and Library Inc. (CMLI) will hold the 25th Annual National Grade School Convention of CMLI Junior Members and Teacher Advisers on September 1-5, 2004 at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City with the theme "The Modern Filipino Youth Hand-in-Hand in Fostering the Spirit of Nationalism".

The highlights of the convention include commission discussion and group dynamic sessions featuring modules on leadership-training, values formation, interpersonal relations and communications; cultural performances to showcase individual and collective talents; keynote address by a prominent national personality; competitions for excellence such as: on-the-spot poster making, OPM singing contest, "pop quiz, hot shot" (marathon of the minds), radio drama (Eng/Pil), writing essay (Eng/Pil.), poetry writing (Eng/Pil.), photo essay, story telling (Eng/Pil.), workshops, symposium, sportsfest, socials and other activities.

The participants are pupils/school leaders, officers and members of the school councils, school paper editors/staff, honor pupils, officers and members of school organizations who serve as coaches/chairpersons from both public and private elementary schools nationwide. Participants from public schools are allowed to attend on official time only.
4. A registration fee of Five Thousand Three Hundred Pesos (PhP5,300.00) will be charged each participant inclusive of board and lodging, convention kits/materials, souvenir programs and other training expenses. Transportation to and from the conference site is not included in this fee.
