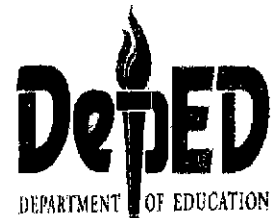

46th ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION OF CMLI JUNIOR
MEMBERS AND TEACHER-ADVISERS

1. The Children's Museum and Library Inc. (CMLI) will hold the 46th Annual National Convention of CMLI Junior Members and Teacher-Advisers on October 25-29, 2004 at Teachers Camp Baguio City with the theme "The Filipino Youth: Upholding Nationalism Towards a Globally Competitive Country."
2. The convention aims to educate the young by increasing their awareness of certain socio-economic developments in the community and the environment.
3. The highlights of the convention include commission discussions and group dynamic sessions featuring modules on leadership-training, values formation, interpersonal relations and communications; cultural performances to showcase individual and collective talents; keynote address by a prominent national personality; competitions for excellence, and the 11th annual inter-secondary school debate tournament finals, workshops, symposium, sportsfest, socials and other activities.

Public and private secondary schools are encouraged to send their student council officers, school paper editors/staffers, outstanding honor students, officers and members of other organizations, and teachers who serve as coaches/chairpersons. Public school teacher-participants are allowed to attend on official time only. Those from private schools may make arrangements with their respective institutions.
5. A convention fee of Five Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (PhP5,700.00) will be charged each participant to cover board and lodging, convention kits/materials, souvenir program and other expenses relative to this convention. Transportation to and from the conference site is not included in this fee.
