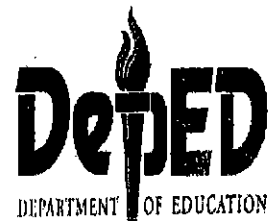

1. Intel Philippines Science Fair (IPSF)

a. The IPSF is an annual nationwide science research competition that aims to promote science and technology consciousness among the youth. It also aims to identify the most creative and the best science student researchers who will represent the country in various science research competitions. Intel Technology Philippines, Inc. (ITPI) is the corporate sponsor of the IPSF.

b. The schedule of the IPSF is as follows:

Expenses of official participants composed of one (1) student researcher and one (1) teacher adviser at the national level competition shall be borne by ITPI while those of the Regional Science and Mathematics (1 each) supervisors shall be charged against local funds, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

2. Intel-DOST-SEI Science Research Seminar-Workshop (SRSW)

- a. The SRSW is a three-day activity which aims to provide teacher participants with the proper knowledge and skills in science research process that will enable them to guide their students in doing quality science research. The activity is likewise sponsored by ITPI.
- b. The target participants are teachers from public and private secondary schools from all regions. Official participants shall be identified based on the set criteria to be announced on a later date.
- c. The SRSW shall be conducted between September 2004 and February 2005.
- d. Official SRSW participants shall be provided with course materials and certificates of participation. Food, lodging and transportation expenses shall be charged against local funds, subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

3. The National Science Club Month (NSCM)

The NSCM is celebrated during the month of September 2004, covering various activities to be organized by the different Science Clubs. The project is under the leadership of the Philippine Society of Youth Science Clubs (PSYSC), Science Club Advisers Association of the Philippines (SCAAP) and the Philippine Association of Science and Mathematics Supervisors (PASMS).
