2004 NATIONAL SCIENCE CLUB MONTH (NSCM)-SCIENCE CLUB ADVISERS OF THE PHILIPPINES (SCAAP) NATIONAL CONVENTION AND EXPO

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 28 on the celebration of the National Science Club Month, the Science Club Advisers of the Philippines (SCAAP), Inc., in cooperation with the DepED-Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (DepED-CSCA) and the PSCI-Journ will conduct the 2004 NSCM-SCAAP National Convention and Expo at the Philippines Carabao Center, Science City, Muñoz, Nueva Ecija on September 26-30, 2004.
- 2. With the theme "Science Club Leaders Transcending to Changing Times and Needs", this event aims to:
  - a. strengthen the implementation of programs and projects in connection with the celebration of the National Science Club Month;
  - b. explore new ideas in adapting to the diverse changes in education, culture and technology;
  - c. enhance knowledge on strategies in developing quality education;
  - d. further develop the awareness of science club advisers/leaders on the state of Philippine Biotechnology related projects for human society; and
  - e. update knowledge on various technological advancements.
- 3. Activities during the 2004 NSCM-SCAAP National Convention and Expo will include plenary sessions, expo visit, cultural presentations, quiz bee, journalism workshop and the convention proper.
- 4. Participants to this convention shall be the science club advisers, science teachers, master teachers, department heads, school principals/administrators, science supervisors and science enthusiasts from both the elementary and secondary public and private schools nationwide.
- 5. A registration fee of Three Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (PhP 3,200.00) shall be charged each participant to cover accommodation and meals from dinner of Day 0 until breakfast of Day 4, training kits, certificates, reproduction of modules and speeches, t-shirts, bags, speakers' honoraria and other incidental expenses of the program chargeable against local funds/local school board funds.

- 6. Members of the National Organizing Committee and Secretariat are allowed to travel two (2) days before the start of the activity.
