

DepED MEMORANDUM No. 401, s. 2004

FIRST NATIONAL ICTs IN BASIC EDUCATION CONGRESS

To: Bureau Directors

Directors of Services/Centers and Heads of Units

Regional Directors

Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. The Department of Education (DepED) and the Foundation for Information Technology-Education and Development, Inc. (FIT-ED) will hold the First National ICTs in Basic Education Congress on December 6-7, 2004 at the Waterfront Cebu Hotel, F. Salinas Drive, Lahug, Cebu City.
- 2. With its theme "Creating a Common Ground, Fostering Communities of Practice", the Congress aims to create a forum for sharing experiences, lessons learned, insights and best practices on the use of ICT in teaching and learning; and initiate discussion from the ground level on defining a framework for ICT integration into the basic education curriculum.
- 3. The Congress will feature plenary discussions on key issues such as: What Technologies and Why Use Them, Alternative Assessment, Teacher Professional Development and Policy Directions on ICT Use. Concurrent paper presentations on specific experiences of teachers and practitioners organized by theme and demonstrations of selected educational technologies are also included in the program. Enclosure No. 1 is the tentative schedule of activities.
- 4. The participants to this activity are as follows: (a) Bureau/Center/Regional Directors; (b) Schools Division/City Superintendents; (c) Regional and Division IT Coordinators; and, (d) one (1) Elementary School Teacher and three (3) Secondary School Teachers per Division who are subject area teachers and not Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) or computer teachers. The participants from the Division must be recommended by the Schools Division Superintendent and endorsed by the Regional Director concerned.
- 5. Members of the Secretariat coming from the Department of Education are authorized to register as participants and to travel three (3) days before the event.
- 6. The abovementioned participants shall attend the congress on official business. As such, travel, accommodation, meals not covered by the registration fee, and other incidental expenses, including the registration fee of Three Thousand Pesos (PhP3,000.00) to cover congress kit, I unch and two snacks per day, shall be charged a gainst local funds and local school board funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The standard registration fee for private schools and institutions is Three Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP3,500.00). The participants from private institutions may make arrangements with their respective administrators.

- 7. All interested participants shall, before registering, submit their names to the Regional IT Coordinator who shall consolidate the regional list of participants for submission to the Congress Secretariat.
- 8. For those coming from public schools and institutions, a discount of Six Hundred Pesos (PhP600.00) will be given to those who register and pay on or before October 30, 2004. For private schools and institutions, a Five Hundred Pesos (PhP500.00) discount will be given to those who register and pay on or before October 30, 2004. Enclosure No. 2 is the registration form which may also be accessed online at www.pilipinasschoolnet.org. - 9. Enclosure No. 3 is the list of official hotels and a hotel registration form. Participants are advised to register directly with the chosen hotel on or before November 15, 2004 to avail of special rates for the Congress.
- 10. In conjunction with the Congress, interested parties are invited to present their experiences in using ICTs in basic education during the Congress' paper presentation sessions.
- 11. Teachers from the elementary and secondary levels, curriculum developers, IT coordinators, school administrators, teacher trainers (pre-service and in-service), and other implementers of ICTs in basic education programs may submit abstracts of paper presentations on the themes identified on or before September 30, 2004.
- 12. Enclosure No. 4 contains the guidelines for the submission of abstracts. Abstracts must be 300-400 words in length in Word *.doc or *.rtf file format and must be e-mailed to parinto@pilipinasschoolnet.org or sent by fax to The Program Committee, First National ICTs in Basic Education Congress, FIT-ED at tel. no. (02) 885-0925.
- 13. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
