- 1. The Philippine Military Academy (PMA), the premier military institution of the land announces its Special Entrance Examination on December 29, 2004 at the different examination centers all over the country.
- 2. PMA is offering full tertiary scholarship to deserving Filipino youth who desire to serve the country through the military profession. As full government scholars, cadets enjoy a well rounded quality education and receive salary and allowances while studying. After graduation, PMAers are guaranteed with jobs and are commissioned as regular officers in the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP).
- 3. To become a PMA Cadet, applicants must be:
  - a. Natural born Filipino citizens:
  - b. Of good moral character;
  - c. Single and never been married;
  - d. Have never sired (male) or given birth (female) to a child;
  - e. 5 feet 4 inches tall if male or 5 feet 2 inches if female;
  - f. Born on or after April 1, 1983 and on or before April 1, 1988;
  - g. At least High School graduate with a general average of 80% or higher; and
  - h. Physically fit and able to perform the minimum requirements for the Physical Fitness Test (PFT).
