ORIENTATION WORKSHOP ON CULTURALLY RESPONSIVE CURRICULUM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors

Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

1. The Asian Council for People's Culture will hold the Schools Division Superintendents Orientation Workshop on Culturally Responsive Curriculum on December 1–3, 2004 at the Grand Men Seng Hotel, Davao with the theme *"The Culture Mode across the Curriculum"*.
2. This orientation workshop is being held in cooperation with the Third Elementary Education Project (TEEP) and the Division of Sarangani.
3. The topics to be discussed include the following:
 - a. Indigenous People's Perspectives in Curriculum Development: Case Studies of Community Educators' Approaches in Organizing Learning Areas;
 - b. Constructing Creative Learning Based on Cultural Literacies of Indigenous Children: "The Big Book Project" Report;
 - c. The Culture Mode Across the Curriculum: Experiences and Current Practices in Developing Culturally Responsive Curriculum;
 - d. Training of Teachers: Accelerated Teacher Education for Lumads-Prospects and Challenges; and
 - e. Partnerships That Work – Community Models in Cooperative Education.
4. The Third Elementary Education Project (TEEP) will shoulder travel costs of participants from TEEP areas. Travel expenses of other participants will be charged to DepED Regional Offices or local funds subject to availability and the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
