FIRST PHILIPPINE MULTIPLE INTELLIGENCE CONVENTION

To: Bureau Directors  
Regional Directors  
Schools Division/City Superintendents  
Heads, Public Secondary Schools  
Principals, Regional Science High Schools

1. The Multiple Intelligence International School Foundation (MIISF) in coordination with the Department of Education (DepED), will hold the First Philippine Multiple Intelligence Convention on February 11-12, 2005 at the Manila Hotel, Rizal Park, Manila with the theme "Changing Minds – Teaching and Parenting for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century". The main plenary speaker is Dr. Howard Gardner.
2. The Convention aims to provide opportunities for the participants to:
  - a. learn about the Multiple Intelligence Theory from the proponent Dr. Howard Gardner;
  - b. learn about specific strategies to develop the different intelligences among children through workshops;
  - c. learn how to apply the Multiple Intelligence Theory in the education of regular and special children;
  - d. learn about specific school models that have been applying Multiple Intelligences in their classrooms; and
  - e. connect with professionals, parents and other stakeholders in the Philippines and around the world.
3. Regular and special education teachers, pre-elementary school teachers, school heads, supervisors, chiefs, assistant chiefs of elementary and secondary education divisions and other key officials from the division, regional and bureau offices in both public and private institutions are invited to attend on **official business**.
4. A special registration fee for DepED personnel of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) will be charged for each participant to this live-out Convention. This will cover lunch, morning and afternoon snacks for two (2) days, conference materials, honoraria for speakers and miscellaneous expenses. Expenses incident to the participation of DepED teachers, coordinators, administrators, supervisors, elementary education division chiefs and assistant

chiefs and other officials shall be charged to local funds, school board funds or other sources. Participation is at the option of the regions. Teacher-participants should be substituted.

5. Enclosed are the Program of Activities and pre-registration form which should be accomplished and received by the Convention Secretariat on or before January 31, 2005.
