CONDUCT OF THE PHILIPPINE NORMAL UNIVERSITY-CENTER FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION AND EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP (PNU-CCEEL)

TRAINING PROGRAMS

- 1. The Department of Education (DepED) through the Philippine Normal University-Center for Continuing Education and Educational Leadership (PNU-CCEL) will conduct Twin Programs intended to enhance professional capabilities of teachers and other personnel in basic education during the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester 2004-2005.
- 2. The objectives and schedules of the programs are as follows:
  - a. b. English Language Proficiency for Teachers (Level 1) – The program aims to re-equip non-English teachers, English teachers, and other professionals with fluency skills in English. This program offers a wide range of opportunities to course participants to get engaged in conversations, small group discussions and class presentations in the target language. It also focuses on listening and speaking capped with grammar exercises through communication situations and various fluency activities. This is the first level in a series of a 3-level continuing education program for English language proficiency for professionals.
