1. The Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE), Department of Education (DepED) in coordination with Christoffel Blindenmission, International (CBMI) will sponsor the training programs for teachers in the following areas for Summer 2005 at the following designated institutions or venues/schedules:

2. These programs aim to upgrade competencies of teachers in providing educational services to children with hearing impairment and those with mental retardation. The training on mental retardation serves as an enhancement program for the teacher-trainees who have undergone preparatory training on mental retardation.

- 3. Priority participants/nominees shall come from the identified regions/divisions/ schools where there is an urgent need for SPED teachers for the hearing impaired and the mentally retarded (See Enclosure Nos. 1-2). Except for nominees for the mentally retarded, applicants for the training on hearing impairment shall be screened by the Regional Integrated Scholarship Committee based on the criteria set in Enclosure No. 3. Deadline for the submission of nominees to the region is on March 15, 2005. The list of nominees together with the documents listed in Enclosure No.3 shall be forwarded to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education not later than March 26, 2005.
- 4. List of teacher-nominees for the training on mental retardation is found in Enclosure No. 2. Each teacher-nominee is required to bring with him/her the Certificate of Attendance he/she received in the preparatory training she attended which the Bureau of Elementary Education conducted.
- 5. New batch of teachers trained in the 2004 Summer Training Program for Teachers of the Hearing Impaired at the Philippine Normal University, Manila, Cebu Normal University, Cebu City and Holy Cross College of Davao, Davao City and who have provided educational services to the hearing impaired are considered for the Second Summer Training in 2005. Their names are listed in Enclosure No. 4.
- 6. All grantees are entitled to benefits and privileges indicated in Enclosure No. 3. Travel expenses to and from the venue shall be borne by the sponsoring agencies. Participants to these training programs are advised to travel by sea or land. New participants are advised to be in school before the actual schedule of classes for the entrance examination and other requirements.
- 7. As a requirement, each participant must accomplish the Memorandum of Agreement (Training Contract) duly signed by the proper authorities concerned (See Enclosure No. 5). This will be sent to the SPED Division, Bureau of Elementary Education together with the other required documents.
- 8. State colleges and universities as well as private institutions interested in offering undergraduate and graduate courses in special education or in providing services to children with special needs are encouraged to send their nominees directly to the Special Education Division, Bureau of Elementary Education, Department of Education, DepED Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City with the required documents. Expenses for the training shall be charged to their agency funds.
- 9. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

- 1. Is a Bachelor's degree holder for the elementary/secondary level
- 2. Is actually teaching regular or SPED classes without training at the elementary
- 3. Has a grade point average of 2.0/85 in the undergraduate/graduate/post graduate study
- 4. Is not more than 45 years old
- 5. If married, is not pregnant or a nursing mother
- 6. Has no administrative/criminal record
- 7. Is physically fit, mentally healthy and registers positive attitude and commitment toward work, peers and students
- 8. Is willing to conduct and/or assist in-service training activities after scholarship
- 9. Is willing to defray own expenses in case of delay of stipend/reimbursement of travel expenses
- 10. Has not availed of any scholarship program for the past three (3) years
- 11. Can communicate in both English and Filipino with facility

PERTINENT PAPERS TO BE SUBMITTED TO REGIONAL SPED SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

- 1. Duly Accomplished Form 212 (Personal Data Sheet)
- 2. A Very Satisfactory Performance Appraisal Rating for the past three (3) rating periods
- 3. Certified true copy of Transcript of Records
- 4. Form 86 (Health Certificate)
- 5. Certification from Head Office (Principals/Superintendent/Chief of Elementary Education/Secondary Education Division) that the nominee is actually teaching and recommending him/her for scholarship duly endorsed by the Superintendent and Regional Director.
- 6. Duly accomplished Training Contract

BENEFITS/PRIVILEGES OF TRAINEES/GRANTEES

- 1. Grantees of the training program at the Philippine Normal University, Cebu Normal University and Holy Cross College are entitled to free tuition fee and a monthly stipend of Two Thousand Pesos onlt (P2,000.00)
- 2. Those coming from the National Capital Region, Division of Cebu City and Davao City shall be entitled to a stipend of One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00)

- 6. Organize SPED programs or classes for the hearing impaired and the mentally retarded;
