

NATIONAL WORK-CONFERENCE ON BUILDING MODELS
FOR EVERY CHILD A READER PROGRAM (ECARP)

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools

1. The National Work-Conference on Building Models for ECARP which will focus on the theme "Building ECARP Models for Excellence" will be held on April 11-15, 2005 at Sabin Resort Hotel, Bantique, Ormoc City. ECARP is the acronym for "Every Child a Reader Program", the Department's thrust in making every Filipino child in grades I-III a reader at their appropriate level of schooling.
2. The goal of the work-conference is to provide maximum/optimum intervention through shared responsibility and accountability at different levels i.e. central, regional and division offices and the school. Specifically it aims to:
 - assess ECARP against standards set to identify areas of need; and
 - enhance division ECARP plan implementation through shared responsibility and accountability at different levels.
3. The participants to this work-conference are the Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of the Elementary Education Division of the seventeen (17) regions, the Director, Assistant Director, Division Chiefs and Assistant Chiefs of the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE). The superintendent from one priority division to be chosen by the region will also participate in the conference. List of participants and program of activities are attached as enclosures No. 1 and No. 2 respectively. The participants are requested to bring the following:
 - a) Report card on the status of regional ECARP in 2 formats: a) in technical report form, b) in exhibit/display form using font size 28. See format in Enclosure No. 3
 - b) Pretest and Posttest results of Phil-IRI by Division
 - c) Performance indicators of priority divisions for the last 3 years (SY 2002-2003, 2003-2004 & 2004-2005).
4. Attendance to this activity shall be **on official business**. A registration fee of Six Thousand Pesos (Php6,000.00) shall be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging and other related expenses. Traveling expenses and registration fee shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
