NATIONAL TRAINING WORKSHOPS ON ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM (ALS)
FOR OLD AND NEW MOBILE TEACHERS

Schools Division/City Superintendents

1. The Bureau of Alternative Learning System (BALS) through the Literacy Division will conduct the National Training Workshops on Alternative Learning System for both old and new mobile teachers at Teachers Camp, Baguio City on the following dates:

- a. First Batch : April 11-15, 2005 (for old/original mobile teachers)
- b. Second Batch: April 18-22, 2005 (for new mobile teachers)

2. In general, the two batches of training workshops aim to: a) provide the mobile teachers updated and comprehensive orientation on the two major programs of the BALS: the Basic Literacy Program (BLP) and the Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) System; and b) advocate practical but effective delivery strategies to improve implementation and sustain gains from the said programs.

3. Specifically, the training workshops aim to accomplish the following:

- a.) For old mobile teachers:
 1. To enhance knowledge and skills in the delivery of Basic Literacy Program (BLP) and the Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) Program;
 2. To share and promote best practices and delivery strategies to improve the program implementors' performance;
 3. To draft program sustainability measures, e.g. M&E of learners and tracking system of completers; and
 4. To thresh out list of recommendations to address prevailing issues and concerns on Mobile Teacher Program implementation.
- b.) For new mobile teachers:
 1. To make them conversant on alternative learning system;
 2. To fully orient them on BLP and A&E System and become well-versed on their respective delivery strategies;
 3. To train them on the utilization of BLP and A&E learning materials and assessment tools/techniques; and
 4. To raise their morale and level of commitment to ensure program sustainability.


4. The participants to the said training workshops are the 300 original mobile teachers (first batch) and the 300 newly-appointed mobile teachers (second batch) mandated to implement the ALS programs in the remote and underserved communities in the country. BALS personnel shall serve as facilitators and shall manage the conduct of the training workshops with assistance from the DepED Central Office and ALS Divisions of DepED Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR). Enclosed are the list of participants and the tentative schedule of activities.

5. Registration starts on the afternoon of April 10 for the first batch (old/original mobile teachers) and on the afternoon of April 17 for the second batch (new mobile teachers). Dinner shall be served on these days. Departure will be after breakfast of April 16 and 23, respectively.

6. Expenses relative to the conduct of these training workshops such as travel, board and lodging of all the participants will be charged against BALS funds subject to the usual existing government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Travel expenses of the participants shall be reimbursed by submitting original and official tickets, receipts and other required travel documents upon registration.
