NATIONAL CONGRESS ON CHILDREN'S PARTICIPATION IN INTEGRATED PRODUCTION AND PEST MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools

- 1. The Children's Participation in Integrated Production and Pest Management (CP IPPM) Program, a project with funding support from the Netherlands Government and implemented by World Education (INGO) Philippines, Inc. in collaboration with other institutions namely: Department of Education (DepED), Local Government Units (LGUs) and Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) will conduct a National Congress at Bayview Hotel, Roxas Boulevard, Manila on April 14-16, 2005.
- 2. The National Congress brings together all the stakeholders from the provinces of Antique, Camarines Sur and Davao del Norte. This will serve as appropriate venue to consolidate all the gains achieved throughout the pilot phase of the program, learn from the experiences and insights of each of the three (3) participating provinces, and forge a unified and determined commitment to sustain the program's implementation beyond the initial three-year period.
- 3. Specifically, the national congress aims to:
 - a. showcase the best individual and collective accomplishments and features
 of the CP-IPPM Program as it was implemented in the provinces of
 Antique, Camarines Sur and Davao del Norte;
 - b. serve as a terminal forum for sharing and reflecting on the strengths and development areas of the pilot implementation of the program as well as the potential or emerging opportunities and threats that may yet be encountered; and
 - c. provide an avenue to draw out concrete plans and generate commitments of support for the sustained implementation of the CP-IPPM Program.
- 4. The participants to this National Congress are selected officials of the Department of Education (DepED), Department of Agriculture (DA), Local Government Units (LGUs) representatives, Non Government Organizations (NGOs), and pupils/students from the three (3) pilot provinces. Fifty (50) participants (i.e., twenty (20) officials from DepEd. DA, LGUs, NGOs and thirty (30) pupils/students)

from each province or a total of one hundred fifty (150) participants will be invited to the Congress. Selection of participants from each province will be done by the Division Superintendent and EPP/TLE Supervisor.

- 5. The National Congress Program of Activities is in Enclosure 1 to this Memorandum for the guidance and information of the participants.
- 6. Meals, accommodation, travel and other expenses of participants incidental to the holding of the Congress shall be shouldered by World Education (INGO) Philippines.
