- The Department of Education (DepED) through the Bureau of Elementary Education (BEE) in cooperation with the UNESCO National Commission of the Philippines announces the winners of the Festival of Asian Children's Art Contest. The contest is internationally organized by the Mitsubishi Public Affairs Committee, the Asian-Pacific Federation of the UNESCO Clubs and Associations (AFUCA), and the National Federation of UNESCO Associations in Japan (NFUAJ).
- A total of 1,109 elementary school pupils from public and private schools joined the competition in school year 2004-2005. A national screening was conducted on November 8, 2004 at the BEE Conference Room that selected ten (10) entries which were sent to Japan for the international screening held in Tokyo, Japan on February 23, 2005. The list of awardees is enclosed.
- The Grand Prix winner together with the parent will be invited to a 5-day stay in Japan to attend the Awarding Ceremony at the World Exposition 2005 in Aichi, Japan on July 29, 2005. Expenses attendant to their participation will be shouldered by the international organizers. Recipients of other awards will receive commemorative gifts and certificates from the organizing committee in September 2005.
