## NATIONAL TEACHER'S CONGRESS ON CREATIVITY IN TEACHING

- 1. The SchoolsFirst Initiative in Baguio, the Department of Education Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) and the Center for Learning and Teaching Styles Philippines will hold a three-day National Teachers Congress entitled "Creativity in Teaching" with the theme "The Creative SchoolsFirst Initiative Teacher (SFI): Learning Minds and Touching Hearts." This will be held on May 29-31, 2005 at the Teacher's Camp, Baguio City.
- 2. The Congress aims to equip the participants with creative teaching and facilitating skills necessary to make learning fun and meaningful; enhance the leadership potentials of teachers leading to improved school-parents-community participation; and identify and highlight the dynamic roles of teachers in the context of SFI.
- 3. The expected participants are public and private school administrators, master and head teachers, guidance counselors, subject area coordinators, PTCA officers and curriculum planners.

4. A registration fee of Two Thousand Nine Hundred Pesos (Php 2,900.00) shall be charged per participant to cover board and lodging, conference materials and certificate. Public school participants may charge their registration fees from local funds subject to usual auditing and accounting procedures while private participants shall make arrangements with their respective institutions.

The first meal will be served evening of May 29, 2005. The registration starts at 2:00 PM on the same day.
