GSP 33rd NATIONAL ENCAMPMENT

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Secondary Schools

1. The Girl Scouts of the Philippines (GSP) will be 65 on May 26, 2005. Highlight of the celebration is a simultaneous 33rd National Encampment on October 22-30, 2005 in the following venues of the six (6) Girl Scouting Regions:

1. Northern Luzon	DND by the Sea, Curimao, Ilocos Norte-Laoag City	GSP @ 65. "Ti Bagas Isu Ti Biag" (Rice is Life)
2. Central Luzon	CLR Campsite, Bamban, Tarlac	GSP @ 65. "KKK: Kalinangan Kaagapay sa Kaunlaran" (Culture Amidst Technological Progress)
3. Southern Luzon	Camp Nepomuceno, Baoac, Marinduque	GSP @ 65: "Sagip-Kalikasan" (Helping Mother Nature)
4. Visayas	Camp Lily Gamo, Dumaguete City, Negros Oriental-Siquijor	GSP @ 65. "Gatubag sa Panginahanglan sa Panahon" (Responding to the Needs of the Times)
5. Eastern Mindanao Camp	Telesfora Ong Oh, Tubay, Agusan del Norte	GSP @ 65. "Ukasa ang Agusan" (Discovering Agusan)
6. Western Mindanao	Alano Farm, Katipunan, Zamboanga del Norte	GSP @ 65. Using Resources Wisely

2. The camp aims to enable participants to:

- a. share critical reflections/insights about specific issues related to themselves (campers) vis-à-vis their rights and responsibilities;
- b. demonstrate the values of teamwork, initiative, respect for others and love of nature as they live with others/patrol members; and
- c. prepare individual and patrol action plans as advocates of children's rights.


3. Such activities complement the purpose of education that the holistic development of a learner is based on the understanding of self and others with emphasis on character education, as they learn to do and live together.

4. The girls will choose the venue and the program of the encampment where they would like to participate in.

5. In view of this, each of the ninety five (95) GSP Councils is encouraged to send 8 to 16 Senior Girl Scouts (High School) and 2-3 troop leaders who will be serving as Camp Staff. All GSP troop leaders are permitted to attend on **official time only.**
