- 2. The camp aims to enable participants to:
  - a. share critical reflections/insights about specific issues related to themselves (campers) vis-à-vis their rights and responsibilities;
  - demonstrate the values of teamwork, initiative, respect for others and love of nature as they live with others/patrol members; and
  - c. prepare individual and patrol action plans as advocates of children's rights.

- 3. Such activities complement the purpose of education that the holistic development of a learner is based on the understanding of self and others with emphasis on character education, as they learn to do and live together.
- 4. The girls will choose the venue and the program of the encampment where they would like to participate in.
- <u>5.</u> In view of this, each of the ninety five (95) GSP Councils is encouraged to send 8 to 16 Senior Girl Scouts (High School) and 2-3 troop leaders who will be serving as Camp Staff. All GSP troop leaders are permitted to attend on <u>official time</u> only.
