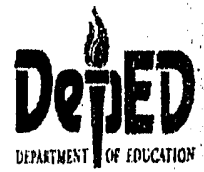



STUDENT GOVERNMENT PROGRAM (SGP) ANNUAL PLANNING
AND EVALUATION CONFERENCE

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Secondary Schools

1. The DepED-Center for Students and Co-Curricular Affairs (CSCA) will conduct the Student Government Program Annual Planning and Evaluation Conference on June 23-27, 2005 at the Paras Beach Resort, Camiguin Island.
2. This annual conference aims to achieve the following objectives:
 - a. Discuss ways of integration of the Department's new efforts on Schools First Initiative (SFI) to the Student Government Program;
 - b. Evaluate the SGP implementation, including the conduct of the 2nd National Leadership Training for Student Government Officers (NLTSGO);
 - c. Identify and resolve issues and concerns pertinent to the SGP implementation;
 - d. Plan and agree on the thrust and activities of the SGP for the coming school year;
 - e. Plan for the conduct of the 3rd NLTSGO;
 - f. Discuss ways in harnessing the student government as an effective partner in achieving quality education and academic excellence in schools; and,
 - g. Improve efforts in making available real exposure, experience and learning in responsible and participative democracy and leadership.
3. Participants to this evaluation and planning conference are the Secondary Education Division *Araling Panlipunan* Regional Supervisors or the Regional Coordinators in-charge of the Student Government Program or their authorized representatives and DepED-CSCA personnel.
4. Participants are expected to be at the venue in the morning of 23 June 2005. The CSCA shall only shoulder board and lodging beginning lunch of June 23, 2005 until breakfast of June 27, 2005.
5. Travel expenses and other incidental expenses of participants shall be charged against local funds. Expenses for board and lodging, supplies and materials shall be shouldered by the DepED-CSCA.
