





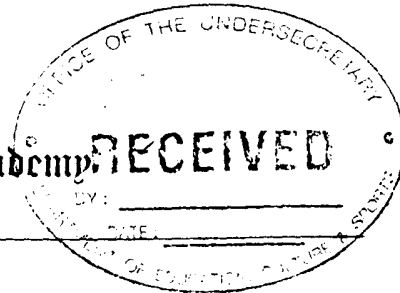

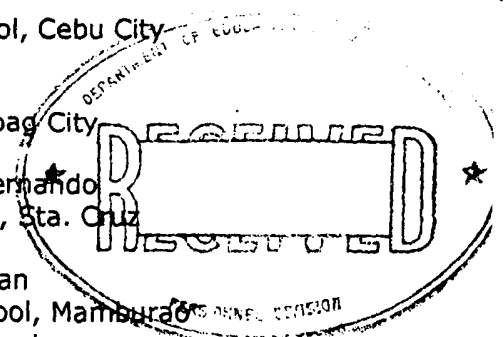

2. Electrical Expenses

No electrical expenses were shouldered by PMMA during the conduct of its entrance examination at the different testing centers. Please be informed that the use of the testing centers is for four (4) hours only. Secondly, the number of classrooms to be utilized is based on the number of applicants in the area (30 examinees/classroom). In view thereof, we will be waiting for your comment regarding this matter.
