2005 NATIONAL TRAINING-WORKSHOP ON CURRENT TRENDS AND INNOVATIONS IN THE ALTERNATIVE LEARNING SYSTEM

To: Undersecretaries Assistant Secretaries **Bureau Directors** Directors of Services/Centers and Heads of Units Regional Directors

Confronted by the educational challenges particularly the new developments and emerging demand in the delivery of programs and projects for Alternative Learning System (ALS), the Bureau of Alternative Learning System (BALS), through the Staff Development (SDD), will conduct the 2005 National Training-Workshop on Current Trends and Innovations in the Alternative Learning System Implementation for District ALS Coordinators nationwide at Teacher's Camp, Baguio City on the following dates:

#### **Batch/Group Participants**

a) Batch 1 (Luzon participants)

October 3-7, 2005

b) Batch 2 (Visayas and Mindanao participants)

November 14-18, 2005

- This training workshop aims to: (a) equip the participant with a holistic knowledge, attitudes, values and skills (KAVS) in order to perform their roles effectively; (b) gain essential KAVS in the teaching-learning strategies, adult learning approaches, alternative assessment techniques, coordinating ALS programs and effective monitoring and evaluation; and (c) respond/address prevailing ALS-related issues/problems being encountered.
- The participants are the District ALS Coordinators whose major tasks are to promote the ALS programs in their respective community and to coordinate same to other stakeholders for sustainability.
- A registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (PhP5,000.00) shall be charged each participant. Expenses for the board and lodging, seminar kit, and supplies and materials will be drawn from the registration fees while registration fee and travel expenses of BALS officials and staff and other incidental expenses relative to the conduct of the said training workshop shall be charged against the BALS Funds. The registration fees and travel expenses of each participant shall be charged against their respective local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

- 5. Registration starts in the afternoon of October 2 (for Batch 1) and in the afternoon of November 13 (for Batch 2). Dinner shall be served on these days. Departure shall be after breakfast of October 8 and November 19, respectively.
