PEACE EDUCATION WORKSHOPS IN CONFLICT-AFFECTED AREAS (with Orientation on and Distribution of Peace Teaching Exemplars)

To: Regional Directors
Schools Division/City Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary Schools

- 1. The Department of Education (DepED), through the Staff Development Division, Human Resource Development Service (SDD, HRDS) and the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), the Office of the Presidential Adviser on the Peace Process (OPAPP) and UNICEF, will conduct the Peace Education Workshops in Conflict-Affected Areas starting September 2005 to June 2006 in 15 regions.
- 2. The workshops are designed to: (a) provide the participants with proper perspective on the peace concepts and peace education process; (b) help them clarify their roles in the promotion of schools as zones of peace and peace efforts in the community; (c) equip them with conflict-resolution techniques which are useful in handling school-related disputes and in maintaining peace at the intra/inter-personal and in/between groups; and (d) build commitment to peace education through the use of the peace teaching exemplars in classroom teaching.
- 3. The workshops will involve school administrators and/or Makabayan teachers from schools in priority barangays/municipalities identified by OPAPP and UNICEF as conflict-affected. The workshop is also open to regional and division supervisors of Makabayan. Each batch will have 100 participants. The regional offices are requested to identify the participants using the enclosed list of schools. The complete list of participating schools, the training schedules and venues are in the enclosures. Reporting time to the venue is evening of day 0.
- 4. Travel expenses and per diem (before and after) of participants are chargeable against local funds while board and lodging expenses of participants and resource persons/facilitators are shouldered by DepED and UNICEF on 50%-50% cost-sharing, except for Regions ARMM, VIII, XII (to be shouldered by UNICEF) and Regions II, III and IV A&B (to be shouldered by DepEd). Other expenses such as supplies, travel and per diem of DepED facilitators and resource persons, honoraria of external resource persons and other incidental expenses are chargeable against Special Program funds. All expenses are subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
