## OF THE TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE TEACHING EXEMPLARS AND STUDENT HANDBOOK ON THE RULE OF LAW

- 1. Pursuant to Executive Order No. 361 entitled "Establishing the Policy of Promoting Awareness of and Respect for the Rule of Law in the Basic Educational System", the Department of Education (DepED) together with the Supreme Court and the Lawyers' League for Liberty (LIBERTAS) has conceptualized the Public Education on the Rule of Law Advancement and Support (PERLAS) Project.
