2005 NATIONAL LITERACY CONFERENCE

To: Bureau Directors
Regional Directors
Directors of Services/Centers and Heads of Units
Schools Division/City Superintendents

- 1. In celebration of the annual Literacy Week, the Department of Education (DepED), through the Literacy Coordinating Council (LCC), in cooperation with other Government Organizations (GOs), Local Government Units (LGUs), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) will hold the National Literacy Conference for the year 2005 at the Manila Pavilion Hotel, U.N. Avenue, Ermita, Manila on September 6-8, 2005.
- 2. The theme of the Conference is "Sustainable Development through Educational Reforms, Values Enhancement, Village Literacy Interventions and Community Education".
- 3. The objectives of the Conference are to:
 - identify educational reforms and literacy development efforts calculated to contribute to sustainable development;
 - b. provide opportunities for developing values, behavior and lifestyles favorable for sustainable development; and
 - c. serve as a venue for sharing experiences in implementing functional literacy programs that are conducive to sustainable development.
- 4. The following participants are expected to attend the Conference:
 - a. Bureau, Center and Regional Directors or their representatives;
 - b. Bureau/Regional Chiefs, Supervisors and Coordinators for Alternative Learning System (ALS);
 - c. Schools Division/City Superintendents, especially those from provinces with lowest literacy rates or regions with winning entries;
 - d. Other government agencies with extension programs involving literacy or continuing education;
 - e. NGOs involved in universalizing literacy in every region;
 - f. LGUs;
 - g. Private/Corporate Foundations with interest in education of literacy; and
 - h. Academic Institutions.
- 5. Participants are requested to check in at 12:00 noon on September 6, 2005 and check out at 12:00 noon on September 8, 2005 or coordinate with the LCC Secretariat.

- 6. A registration fee of Four Thousand Pesos (PhP4,000.00) will be charged each participant to cover expenses for board and lodging, handouts, kits and other workshop supplies and materials. Transportation and other incidental expenses of the participants shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Enclosed is the tentative program of activities.
- 7. LCC will underwrite the transportation, board and lodging of the 2005 National Literacy Awards top five (5) winners per category.
- 8. Accommodation will be on a first come, first served basis. Names of participants may be sent to Dr. Norma L.
