> 26TH ANNUAL NATIONAL GRADE SCHOOL CONVENTION AND THE 47TH ANNUAL NATIONAL CONVENTION FOR HIGH SCHOOL

- The Children's Museum and Library, Inc. (CMLI) will hold the 26th Annual National Grade School Convention on September 5-9, 2005 and the 47th Annual National Convention for High School on October 26-30, 2005 at the Teachers Camp, Baguio City. The theme for both events is "The Heroic Youth Waging the War Against Pornography and Moral Degeneration".
- The highlights of the convention include the following: (a) group dynamics and discussion sessions featuring modules on leadership-training, values formation, interpersonal relationship and communication; (b) cultural performances to showcase individual and collective talents; (c) keynote address by a prominent national personality; (d) competitions for excellence (on-the-spot poster making, OPM singing contest, pop quizhot shot, radio drama, story telling for elementary level only, news writing, essay writing, and poetry writing); and (e) workshops, symposium, sportsfest, socialization and other activities.
- The participants to these activities are pupils/students/school leaders, officers and members of the school councils, school paper editors/staffers, outstanding honor pupils, officers and members of school organizations who may be recommended by the school principals and their respective Local Government Units (LGUs). Participants from public schools are allowed to attend on official time only.
- A registration fee of Five Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (PhP5,500.00) will be charged each participant for the Grade School Convention and Five Thousand Seven Hundred Pesos (PhP5,700,00) each for the High School Convention inclusive of board and lodging, convention kit/materials, and other training expenses, which can be sourced from other funding associations.
