ANNOUNCING THE 5TH PHILIPPINES SCHOOL CYBER FAIR PROJECT 2006

To: **Bureau Directors** Regional Directors Schools Division/City Superintendents Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools

- The DigitalFilipino.com, in collaboration with the Department of Education (DepED) through the Bureau of Secondary Education-Curriculum Development Division (BSE-CDD) and the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) through the Office of Special Concerns (OSC), is announcing the 5th Philippines School Cyber Fair Project 2006. The fair carries the theme "Inspire and Unite", and is open to all public and private elementary and secondary schools with Internet connection.
- 2. The online activity aims to:
  - a. encourage pupils/students to become community ambassadors by working collaboratively and using technology to share what they have learned:
  - b. link the knowledge and skills they learn in the classroom to real world community problems by conducting research projects; and
  - share the results of their project's findings on the Internet. C.
- All online entries must be written and presented in English or Filipino. A group of students in a public or private elementary and secondary school may submit multiple entries at one entry per category, per level (elementary/secondary). The eight categories, which encourage the pupils/students to "shine the spotlight" on people, places, businesses and other things in their local community that serve to "inspire, motivate, and encourage positive change", are as follows:

local leaders a. environment b. businesses f. music community organizations art C. g. historical landmarks h. local specialties

Judging of entries shall be done online whereby Cyberfair participants evaluate each other's projects by using a unique online evaluation tool.

- 5. The prizes for the <u>regional level</u> (August-November 2005) and the <u>national level</u> (November 2005-March 2006) are as follows:
  - a. Trophy for the school, medal for students;
  - b. Regional/National IT leadership convention for all Cyberfair participants; and
  - c. 5-day teacher training on e-Learning content development (national level only).
