SCHOOL CHILDREN'S ORAL HEALTH AWARENESS WEEK

1. The Department of Education (DepED), through the Health and Nutrition Center (HNC), will celebrate the School Children's Oral Health Awareness Week on October 9-15, 2005.

2. All the school dentists, and school health and nutrition personnel are expected to conduct the following activities :

Monday Creating Awareness on the celebration through:
a. announcement during the flag raising ceremony;
b. display of streamers;
c. use of multi-media in the locality;
d. publication in local newspapers and school papers,
and
e. TV and radio goesting.

Tuesday: Sodium Fluoride mouthrinsing activities in schools.

Wednesday: Conducting the following activities in cooperation with the
and
Philippine Dental Association (PDA) Chapters and other
dental organizations:

Thursday: a. Dental services like oral health examination,
treatments, consultations, etc.,
b. toothbrushing drills; and
c. Oral health education.

Friday: Lectures/symposia on the importance of oral hygiene.

3. Activities to be undertaken must not disrupt regular classes.

4. The awarding of the winners of the Poster Making Contest for the Bright Smiles, Bright Futures (BSBF) Program will be undertaken to highlight the week-long

celebration. Special recognition shall be given to the following Global Winners whose artworks were submitted to Colgate-Palmolive-New York and who were chosen as 3 of 12 winners.
